## Confirming your Identity and Signature



To meet the requirements for a Medallion Signature Guarantee stamp, you must provide identification which has been certified by a solicitor or notary public. Please provide <u>one</u> document from list A and <u>one</u> document from list B.

The documents that require the Medallion Signature Guarantee must also be signed in the presence of the solicitor or notary public who certifies the documents ("the Certifier").
