What has happened to Fletcher Day Limited?

The Solicitors Regulation Authority has closed down the practice of Fletcher Day Limited, 30 Moorgate, London, EC2R 6DA, England. This happened on 22 February 2023. Lester Aldridge is helping the SRA with the closure.

What happens now?
