#### What has happened to H K Solicitors?

The Solicitors regulation Authority have closed down the practice of H K Solicitors of Suite 2-08, Peel House, 34-44 London Road, Morden, Surrey, SM4 5HP. This happened on 14 October 2016. Lester Aldridge is helping the SRA with the closure.

#### What happens now?

H K Solicitors can no longer act for its clients. If you were a client, you will need to find a new solicitor. You can find a list of solicitors in England and Wales on the <u>Law Society's website</u>.

### What has happened to my file?
