What has happened to Howlett Clarke Solicitors LLP?

The Solicitors Regulation Authority have closed down the practice of Howlett Clarke Solicitors LLP of 96 Church Street, Brighton, East Sussex, BN1 1UJ. This happened on 10 May 2019. Lester Aldridge is helping the SRA with the closure.

What happens now?
