What has happened to K Law Solicitors?

The Solicitors Regulation Authority has closed down the practice of K Law Solicitors of The Old Court House, London Road, Ascot, SL5 7EN. This happened on 26 June 2020. Lester Aldridge is helping the SRA with the closure.

What happens now?

K Law Solicitors can no longer act for its clients. If you were a client, you will need to find a new solicitor. You can find a list of solicitors in England and Wales on the <u>Law Society's website</u>.

What has happened to my file?
